The exiled **COMMUNITIES OF OPPRESSED MINORITIES AND PEOPLES** and the Liberal Cultural Association **SOCIETÀ LIBERA** have been organizing for six years the **INTERNATIONAL MARCH FOR FREEDOM**, a silent demonstration that aims to safeguard the principle of Freedom, considered as an individual right, and as the right for the self-determination of Peoples.

It is high time for the Western world to shake up and go into action about the condition of hundreds of millions of people, who are daily denied the right to fundamental freedoms

It is high time that squares in Europe fill up with people who are aware that the defense of Freedom, wherever it is jeopardized, is a common stake.

Consistently with the conception of Liberalism, which acknowledges a central role of the Person and his/her natural rights, we appeal to the peoples of Europe and to media organizations, so that the defense of Human Rights becomes an international priority. Because of this we have presented to the European Parliament the following **Declaration**:

• considering the worsening of the situation of human rights in the world and the absence of fundamental liberties, suffered by many peoples, minorities and communities;

• considering that the European Union is inspired by the principles of universality and indivisibility of human rights together with the respect of the rights of minorities;

• deeming as fundamental for the European Union to concretely mobilize in defending the rights of minorities;

• considering the "March for Freedom" organized each year by the Association "Società Libera" and the exiled Communities of Oppressed Minorities and Peoples;

we invite the European Union to establish the

European Day for the Freedom of Oppressed Minorities, Communities, and Peoples.
